Electronic Room Nights Grew 26% for Asia-Pacific in Q1 *TravelCLICK Announces Top Ten Hotel Markets in Asia-Pacific*

CHICAGO (XX May, 2004) - TravelCLICK reported today that Asia-Pacific region room nights booked electronically through the Global Distribution Systems (GDS) and key Internet sites increased 25.8% in the first quarter of 2004 compared to the prior year period. In comparison, GDS worldwide room nights increased 9.5% for first quarter of 2004 versus first quarter of 2003.

The average daily rate (ADR) for the Asia-Pacific region was \$136.29, an improvement of 11.5% over the same quarter last year.

TravelCLICK's reports are compiled from its comprehensive database, which is the exclusive source of hotel industry electronic distribution data from the Abacus/Infini, Axxess, Amadeus, Galileo, Sabre, and Worldspan GDS.
