Electronic Room Nights Up 13% for Asia-Pacific Hotels in Q3 2005

TravelCLICK's eMonitor Reports Top Ten Destinations in Asia-Pacific

CHICAGO (19 December 2005) – TravelCLICK's eMonitor results for the third quarter 2005 illustrates that Asia-Pacific room nights booked electronically through the Global Distribution Systems (GDS) and key Internet sites increased 13.7% versus the same quarter last year. Worldwide electronic room nights also increased, up 2.2% for the third quarter of 2005.

The average daily rate (ADR) for the Asia-Pacific region was \$140.33, an increase of 9.4% over the third quarter of 2004. This increase exceeded the 7.1% worldwide growth in ADR.

“Electronic room night bookings from all top ten Asia Pacific markets grew within the third quarter,” said Jan Tissera, President of TravelCLICK International. “Average daily rate within the Asia Pacific region is over \$140.00 – over \$8.00 higher when compared to worldwide ADR.”

TravelCLICK's reports are compiled from its comprehensive database, which is the exclusive source of hotel industry electronic distribution data from the Abacus/Infini, Axess, Amadeus, Galileo, Sabre and Worldspan GDS.
