Electronic Room Nights Increase Over 29% for Middle Eastern Hotels in Q4 2005

TravelCLICK's eMonitor Reports Top Ten Destinations in Middle East

CHICAGO (10 April 2006) – TravelCLICK's eMonitor results for the fourth quarter of 2005 shows a 29.6% increase in room nights booked electronically through the Global Distribution Systems (GDS) and key Internet sites for the Middle East compared to the same time period in 2004. This increase drastically surpasses the 7.1% worldwide growth in room nights for the fourth quarter.

The Average Daily Rate (ADR) for hotels in the Middle East was **\$209.20**, an increase of 15.4% versus the fourth quarter of 2004.

eMonitor results are compiled from TravelCLICK's comprehensive database, which is the exclusive source of hotel industry electronic distribution data from the Amadeus, Galileo, Sabre and Worldspan GDS. TravelCLICK's eMonitor also includes hotel bookings made through third-party travel Internet websites powered by Pegasus Solutions.
